Task and responsibilities:

To visit vulnerable clients in their own homes and assist our clients in completing Leicester Charity Link's grant application form. Gathering all relevant information relating to and required on the application form. Completing other charities application forms with the client as and when needed. Arranging visits with clients.

Skills required:

Excellent communication skills and friendly manner.
Methodical approach.
Good reading and writing skills and able to compose short but detailed social reports.
Driving Licence would be helpful but not essential as public transport could also be used.

This is an opportunity to be involved in helping the most vulnerable people in our society and is a very valued position. Experience will be gained in administrative procedures along with charitable fund raising and liaising with various professional and their organisations.

Hours/time commitment:

2 – 8 hours per week as visits dictate. There is a need to be flexible.

Location:

Based at Leicester Charity Links city office, with visits in both Leicester City and Leicestershire and Rutland if possible.

Training:

Informal in house training covering all aspects of the post.

Director of Operations

Expenses:

All travel expense to and from office location and all home visits. Any other reasonable out of pocket expenses.
